Dear Parents,

Please find attached your child's report for the academic year 2021/2022.

This year's reports are in the same format as last year which is uniform through all the Xavier Primary Schools.

Attendance

Reporting attendance has been problematic this year due to the way Covid absence has been reported. Prior to January 2022, all Covid cases were **not** included in your child's overall attendance. However, from January 2022, we were instructed by Surrey County Council to record all Covid absences as 'ill'. Therefore, your child's attendance may be skewed depending on when they were off school with Covid. Please be assured that the school has a very clear record as to when a child has contracted Covid.

Attainment

We are all very aware of the disruption Covid has had on all children nationally. Our data reflects the national picture at present in that many children may still be working towards the expected standard, in particular, children in the Early Years and Key Stage 1. This is most pronounced in writing and we continue to give the support required.

Year 2 and 6 SATs.

The Department for Education has reintroduced end of Key Stage SATs for Years 2 and 6. This is the first time that these have taken place since lockdown and the tests have not been altered in any way to reflect disruption caused by Covid over the past couple of years. Credit should be given to the children for the resilience and perseverance that they have shown.

Attitude to Learning

The report makes reference to behaviour and effort, with four judgements for each. Please note that this is based on your child's attitude to learning which covers a wide range of learning behaviours such as resilience, application and ability to working independently. If your child has room for improvement, we will monitor this next year. If there is an area highlighted 'Cause for Concern', this should not come as a surprise. If you were not aware, please contact your child's teacher.



As always, I have been incredibly proud of the children and staff's determination, resilience and positivity over yet another challenging year. Our aim this year was to ensure that you child grows in confidence and enjoys their learning.

We will continue next year to do our very best for all the children in our care and thank you again for all your support.
