

# Year 4 Art and Design Skills- I Can...

## Investigation

- I can explore relationships between line and tone, pattern and shape, line and texture and make informed choices in drawing, including use of paper and media.
- I can show increasing independence and creativity with the printing process, demonstrating a willingness to experiment and take risks.
- I can research, create and refine a print using a variety of techniques.
- I can explore resist printing including marbling and silkscreen.
- I can experiment with paste resist.
- I can find out about artists, architects and designers.

## Observation

- I can use research to inspire drawings from memory and imagination.
- I can alter and refine drawings and describe changes, based on close observations, using appropriate vocabulary.
- I can match the correct tool to the material.
- I can observe, talk about my own and others' work, understanding if it has been sculpted, modelled or constructed.

## Application

- I can make informed choices in drawing including use of paper and media.
- I can collect images and information independently in an art book.
- I can make and match colours with increasing accuracy.
- I can use more specific colour language e.g. tint, tone, shade, hue.
- I can plan and create different effects and textures with paint.
- I can print using a variety of materials, objects and techniques including layering.
- I can choose collage or textiles as a means of extending work already formed.
- I can show an understanding of shape, space and form.
- I can plan, design, make and adapt models using a variety of materials.
- I can talk about my work, understanding that it has been sculpted, modelled or constructed.
- I can design and create images and models for clearly defined purposes.
