

Year 5 Art and Design Skills- I Can...

Investigation

- I can research and use a variety of sources material for my work.
- I can explore the potential properties of the visual elements of line, tone, pattern, texture, colour and shape.
- I can investigate, explore and record information to generate imaginative ideas.
- I can work on preliminary studies to test media and materials.
- I can find out about artists, architects and designers.

Observation

- I can work in a sustained and independent way from observation, experience and imagination
- I can become familiar with new techniques e.g. the use of poly-blocks, relief, mono and resist printing.
- I can compare and comment on ideas, methods and approaches used in my work and others' work, beginning to relate these to intention, in order to adapt and improve outcome.

Application

- I can use an art book to develop ideas.
- I can demonstrate a secure knowledge about primary and secondary, warm and cold, complementary and contrasting colours.
- I can choose the printing method appropriate to task.
- I can build up layers, colours and textures.
- I can organise my work in terms of pattern, repetition, symmetry or random printing styles.
- I can join fabric in different ways, including stitching.
- I can use a range of media to create collage.
- I can use recycled, natural and man-made materials to create sculpture.
- I can plan a sculpture through drawing and other preparatory work
- I can design and create images and artefacts in response to personal ideas and for clearly defined purposes by selecting and developing techniques and using a range of materials.
