I can experiment with different shades of pencil and other implements.

I can experiment with different effects and textures e.g. blocking in colour, colour washes, thickened paint etc.

I can explore pattern and shape, creating designs for printing.

I can experiment with a range of media e.g. overlapping, layering.

I can find out about artists, architects and designers.

I can use my art book to observe, collect and record visual information from different sources.

I can observe and discuss the processes used to produce a simple print.

I can use different media to achieve variations in line, texture, tone, colour, shape and pattern.

I can work confidently on a range of scales e.g. thin brush on small picture etc.

I can mix a variety of colours and I know what primary colours make secondary colours.

I can print using a variety of materials, objects and techniques including layering.

I can begin to work independently.
